Level Twenty Seven Chambers continues to be open for business as usual. We also continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation, adjusting our response as the situation unfolds.

In light of recent reported cases in Queensland, Level Twenty Seven Chambers requests that individuals who have been in [these locations](#) since the dates stated in the link not visit Chambers without first advising a barrister or staff member of the proposed visit. Where practicable, other means of meeting will be arranged.

In addition, we ask that all considering visiting Chambers continue to take reasonable precautions. In particular, we ask that:

1. You do not attend chambers if you have not completed any period of mandatory quarantine.
2. You do not attend Chambers if you are experiencing cold or flu like symptoms or have done so within 14 days prior to the attendance and have not received medical clearance.
3. You do not attend Chambers if you have come into close contact with a person confirmed as having a COVID-19 infection within the prior 14 days.
4. When attending Chambers otherwise, you observe required social distancing measures and recommended hand hygiene.
4. If you have visited Chambers and you subsequently become aware of being in contact with a confirmed COVID case within 14 days prior to your visit, you contact us immediately.

Obviously, the position is constantly and rapidly evolving. Chambers has taken steps to ensure that in the event of changes in guidance, client services will still continue with no or minimal disruption. Any developments will be notified on our website.
